Elite-Commoner Relations in A State



Why elites / rulers must be responsible to the people / commoners?

- 1. Three conditions for a state: an area / jurisdiction, effective government, people.
- 2. The government legitimacy is determined by the people *public office is public consent*
- 3. Resources and fundings for the government are from the poeple. The government activities are funded by the APBN/APBD, which funds are levied from taxes and service charges.

Why government agencies' performance is generally low?

- 1. Bureaucrats are mostly oriented to power and positions.
 - →Shifting the pattern from "the rulers" to the "servants" is very difficult.

Paternalistic cultures, superior-oriented reports (Asal Bapak Senang), briberies, too much privilege to the authorities.

- 2. A big gap between the policy, its implementation, and the people's aspirations.
- Politics vs. administration dilemma. → narrow interests are frequently given priorities.

TRANSPARENCY

- 1. Definition: precision, the accuracy for the people and the public when they access information on public policy-makers and the bureaucrats. When an activity is transparent, all the information on it would be available for everybody.
- Barrington Moore (1967): Transparency means: 1) effective checks and restraints on power holders; 2) mechanisms for replacement of illegitimate rulers; and 3) the participation of ordinary people in the making of rules.
- Four pillar of 'good governance' (UNDP): 1) accountability, 2) predictability, 3) public participation, and 4) transparency.

The Meaning of Transparency in Economic Terms

- The people's access for information is an important instrument for economic development. The economic theories (e.g. Harrod-Domar models) give too much emphasis on finansial resources.
- The role of information as a resource is frequently overlooked, for some it was an intentional move to block information streams.
- Information must be perceived as a fundamental capitals or assets. Joseph Stiglitz says that there are economic defficiencies in countries due to digital gaps.

The Meaning of Transparency in Political Terms

- 1. It would ensure accountability of the decisionmakers, the people can control politicians and bureaucrats.
- 2. The *checks and balances* so that there is no power monopoly among the politicians / and or buraucrats.
- 3. There will be no power monopoly among decision makers.

4. Increase efficiency in public service
